CALL FOR REGISTRATION OF DRIVERS OF HEAVY GOODS VEHICLES (HGVs) AND ENGINEERING PLANT/MACHINE OPERATORS

The Ministry of Works and Transport in collaboration with the Petroleum Authority of Uganda (PAU) are in the process of identifying competence gaps for drivers of Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGV) and Engineering Plant/Machine Operators. This is in preparation for the development and construction activities in the Oil and Gas sector. Studies undertaken in the Oil and Gas Sector estimated that over 2,700 drivers will be required, particularly for heavy-duty trucks, tankers and over 900 operators of engineering machines for the different projects in the Oil and Gas Sector in Uganda.

In view of the need to prepare Ugandans to take up these opportunities, there is need for a countrywide registration exercise. The purpose of the exercise is therefore to establish the available number of HGV drivers and machine operators in the country, their competence levels and current employment status among others.

This is therefore to invite all HGV drivers and Engineering Machine Operators **who are currently available in country** to register with the Ministry of Works and Transport. The registration procedure shall be as follows:

- All drivers who possess driving permits with classes CM, CH and G are invited to complete the registration Form, this applies to operators as well.
- Attach on the registration form a copy of the National Identify Card, copy of the driving permit and any other support documents such as additional certification in HGV/Operator training, Health and safety, among others.
- The registration forms can be accessed/downloaded from the Ministry of Works and Transport Website (www.works.go.ug) or from the Petroleum Authority of Uganda website (www.pau.go.ug). Printed Registration forms can also be picked from: PAU Liaison Offices on 4th Floor Amber House, Kampala; or, Ministry of Works and Transport offices at any of the following locations: Transport Licensing Board offices in Kampala or its regional offices in Mbale, Fortportal and Mbarara; or, from Face Technologies offices in Kampala, Mbarara, Fortportal, Gulu, Mable, Arua, and Jinja.

All completed registration forms should be sent to driversregistration@works.go.ug, or submitted to the Ministry of Works and Transport or at any of the locations mentioned above not later than 5.00pm East African Time on **Thursday, 28th February 2019**.
